SENEDIA Fall Internship and Direct Hire Program

The SENEDIA Fall Internship and Direct Hire Program is open. This program, which is funded by the RI Department of Labor and Training's Real Jobs RI program, works to connect the membership with intern and direct hire candidates. Candidates are available from cybersecurity, engineering, business administration, logistics, marketing, and so much more. In addition to connecting companies with intern candidates, this program also provides a stipend for the first 80-hours of their internship and opportunities for industry recognized certifications. The SENEDIA team works with the regional colleges and universities, as well as the state and federal Veterans Affairs departments to source highly qualified candidates.
